STUDY VISA

Study Visa is a legal document issued to foreigners to enable them gain entrance to different countries to pursue education at different levels. For anyone to be able to study in foreign countries, it is very important to get a Study Visa. Just like the Work Visa, the Study Visa processing varies according to different countries:

1. Australia Study Visa: There are different visas available and the choice depends on which fits the applicant's circumstances. There are 7 different visas available.

2. The United States: The United States offers three types of visas. They are **F1**, **M1** and **J1** visa. **M1** is given to those who wish to pursue vocational trainings at the university. **J1** is given to those who wish to pursue research, professors or exchange students who would like to engage in educational programmes that promote cultural exchange. **F1** visa is given to students planning to engage in academic studies at accredited universities.

3. Canada: Canada offers **foreigners study visa**. However, for Canada, while applying for the study visa, it is important to equally apply for the study permit. The study visa is the authorization that allows you to enter the country while the study permit gives you the authority to stay in the country. The study visa is not issued out as a separate document. When the study permit is approved, a **visitor visa or electronic travel authorization** will be issued.

4. The United Kingdom: There are two types of visa specifically issued for studying in the UK. They are **student visa** and the **standard visitor visa**. The standard visitor visa is for courses less than 6 months and student visa is for courses with 1-year duration and above.

DOCUMENTS NEEDED

The following documents are necessary for study visa application

- 1. International Passport (compulsory)
- 2. Certificate (WAEC, BSC) Compulsory
- 3. Transcript (Compulsory)
- 4. IELTS (Optional)
- 5. GRE (Optional)
- 6. Reference letters (Both academic and professional) compulsory

7. Proof of funds
